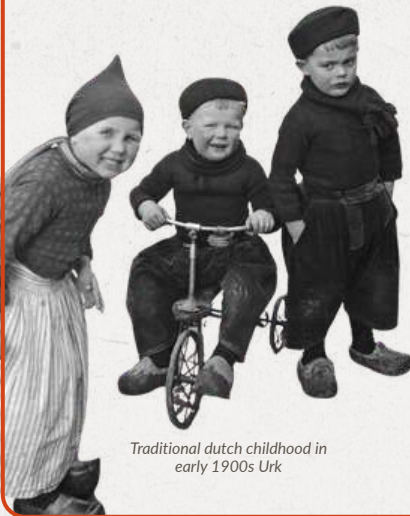
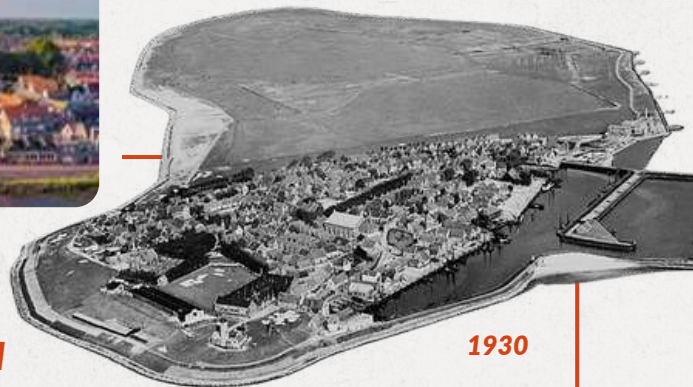

DAY 4 Breda (78km) Haarzuilens (12km) Utrecht (25km) Amersfoort

Meal: B, D | Stay: Fletcher Hotel-Restaurant De Klepperman or similar

- After breakfast, check out from the hotel and travel to **Haarzuilens** to visit the magnificent **De Haar Castle**, one of the Netherlands' most impressive castles, surrounded by beautiful gardens and picturesque landscapes. Continue to **Utrecht** for an orientation tour, exploring its charming historic centre and iconic canals. Afterwards, proceed to Amersfoort for hotel check-in and overnight stay.

- Travel to Lelystad and enjoy free time for shopping at **Batavia Stad Fashion Outlet**, home to a wide selection of international designer and fashion brands. Continue to the charming fishing village of **Urk** for an orientation tour, discovering its historic streets and traditional maritime character.
- Next, proceed to **Giethoorn**, famously known as the "Venice of the Netherlands." Enjoy a relaxing one-hour round-trip **boat cruise** through Giethoorn's picturesque canals, passing charming thatched-roof houses, quaint bridges and tranquil waterways. Afterwards, return to Amersfoort in the evening.

DAY 6 Amersfoort (96km) Alkmaar (46km) Enkhuizen (72km) Amsterdam

Meal: B, D | Stay: OZO President Hotel Amsterdam Airport or similar

- After breakfast, travel to Alkmaar for an orientation tour and a glimpse of the famous **Alkmaar Cheese Market**, where the city's centuries-old cheese-trading tradition comes to life. Continue to **Enkhuizen** and visit the **Zuiderzee Museum**, offering a fascinating insight into the traditional culture, maritime heritage and daily life of the former Zuiderzee region.

DAY 7 Amsterdam (28km) Zaanse Schans (23km) Volendam (16km) Marken (44km) Amsterdam

Meal: B, L, D | Stay: OZO President Hotel Amsterdam Airport or similar

- Travel to **Zaanse Schans** for an orientation tour, discovering its iconic windmills, traditional wooden houses and charming Dutch countryside scenery. Continue to the picturesque fishing village of **Volendam** for a walking orientation tour, exploring its lively harbour, historic streets and traditional Dutch character.
- Next, take a short journey to the charming island village of **Marken** and enjoy an orientation tour, admiring its distinctive wooden houses, quaint lanes and peaceful waterfront before returning to the hotel.

DAY 8 Amsterdam (20km) Lisse (20km) Amsterdam

Meal: B, L | Stay: OZO President Hotel Amsterdam Airport or similar

- After breakfast, travel to Lisse and visit the world-famous **Keukenhof Gardens**, renowned for its spectacular displays of colourful tulips and spring flowers. Continue to Amsterdam for an orientation tour, including a visit to the iconic **Dam Square** and a glimpse of the city's historic landmarks and vibrant atmosphere.
- Enjoy dinner in Amsterdam before returning to the hotel.

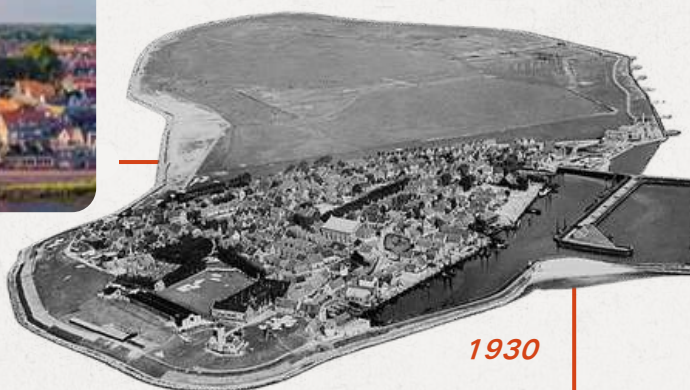

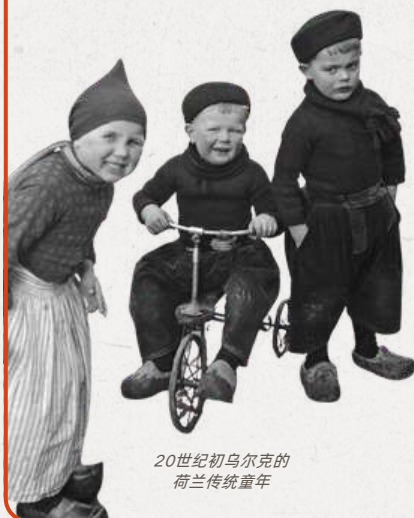

餐食: 晚餐 | 住宿: Intercity Hotel Breda 或同级

- 抵达阿姆斯特丹后, 前往充满活力的港口城市**鹿特丹** (Rotterdam), 展开城市导览, 欣赏其独具特色的现代建筑与繁华都市风貌。随后前往**布雷达** (Breda) 享用晚餐, 餐后办理酒店入住手续, 享受轻松舒适的夜晚与住宿。

第3天 布雷达 (160km) 布鲁日 (101km) 耶瑟克 (70km) 布雷达

餐食: 早, 午, 晚餐 | 住宿: Intercity Hotel Breda 或同级

- 早餐后, 前往充满迷人魅力的**布鲁日** (Bruges), 展开城市导览, 漫步于古色古香的中世纪街道与历史悠久的市中心, 感受浓厚的欧洲古城风情。
